<p>Medical Assistance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students can go to the Campus Health Nurse (1st Floor Mollohan Center) for medical services. • The Campus Health Nurse can provide health services and referrals to Minnie Hamilton Health Systems • A Sexual Forensic Exam is available at the United Health Center (UHC) in Clarksburg, WV. The exam includes preventive treatment for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy and evidence collection. The exam is conducted by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) who is a Registered Nurse with advanced training and certification in conducting sexual assault exams. • A forensic kit and examination can be done for free at United Health Center in Clarksburg, WV. • A police report is not required to receive medical assistance 	<p>Advocacy, Support Services, Housing & Academic Accommodations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The GSC Counseling Center (2nd Floor Lilly Gymnasium) provides information, counseling, & referrals connecting students with an advocate, if requested. A counselor can be contacted by GSC Public Safety 24 hours a day. • The Office of Student Life assists with academic and housing accommodations, referrals, disciplinary and judicial affairs. • The Title IX Coordinator investigates any assaults or interpersonal violence allegations to assist in making appropriate accommodations and intervention to insure student safety. • The Office of Residence Life can assist with housing accommodations. • Hope Inc. has a local victim advocate, as well as a free & confidential 24-hour crisis line.
