Updates on Current Campus Projects:

- Talks are in order for the Health Sciences Buildout.
- The university is discussing demolition of LBH with an engineer.
- There have been several discussions with painting and flooring companies for projects on campus.

- The flooring, furniture and roof has been completed for Clark Hall.
- The Clark Hall cupola should be completed by June.
- The Omni Partners Co-op may allow for a quicker resolution on the Chiller Project.
- Vandal resistant elevator buttons have been installed in the PE Building.

Discussion of Unused Facilities and Future use of those Facilities:

- The Amphitheater will be designed based on the allotted budget for that project.
- Planning and talks of funding needs are taking place for the possibility of renovations to the Football Stadium and Field House.
- Discussions of repairing the President's Auditorium were held. It was suggested that doing external repairs to the building before internal repairs would be more cost efficient.
- The Print Shop will be moved to the "Fort" in Pickens Hall. The area will be secured.

Discussion of Safety Concerns:

- The project for new cameras is being worked on.
- The project for locks will be worked on in Goodwin Hall throughout May 2024.
- Vicious animal reports were discussed.

BIT Discussion:

- The BIT Team is continuing to have emergency meetings with successful results. Training will be offered for Faculty and Staff.

Other Discussions, Updates, and Concerns:
