Autism Endorsement

- Mari asked to move this action ahead on the agenda due to its importance to get to the Curriculum Commitee.
- Gerda presented the endorsement which will consist of 2 courses, 3 credit hours each and 30hrs of field experience. This is for students in the MACI who already have licensure. New courses will be EDSP 570 and EDSP 580
- Kaitlin asked the council to consider cross listing the endorsement with PSYC courses in the future.
- It was suggested to change the title of EDSP 570 to Foundations of Autism and the title of EDSP 580 to Teaching Students with Autism.



• Mari asked if the council was in support of presenting this to the Curriculum Committee and it was approved.

Recruitment

- Mari asked the council ways that we can continue to market graduate programs.
- Dwight updated the council that starting November 1st the MBA will begin developing social media promotion strategy for the MBA. There is \$1,000 from the Business Department budget to be used for marketing the MBA.

- Kaitlin suggested signing MOU's with institutions who do not have a Graduate program to have them promoting our programs to let students know about GSU
